When Sephardic Jews were expelled from Spain in the 15th century, many of them settled in the Bosnian city of Sarajevo (the 'European Jerusalem') and brought to the Balkans a rich cultural heritage celebrated for centuries in song and poetry.

Nearly extinguished in the Holocaust, the remnant of Sarajevo's Jewish community organized to protect Bosnia's Muslim and Christian population under siege in the early 1990s.

Through an evening of song, story, and poetry, Rabbi James Stone Goodman will open a door on the lost Jewish world of Sarajevo.

Tickets are \$5 at the door and will benefit an exhibit on the Bosnian genocide planned for the Holocaust Museum and Learning Center in 2007.
